1. Scriptures for Anxiety and Fear

When worry and fear seem to consume you, these verses remind you of God's presence and peace.

- Philippians 4:6-7: "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."
- Isaiah 41:10: "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand."
- 1 Peter 5:7: "Cast all your anxiety on Him because He cares for you."
- Psalm 34:4: "I sought the Lord, and He answered me; He delivered me from all my fears."
- John 14:27: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid."

2. Scriptures for Guidance and Decision-Making

When you're facing a tough decision, these verses offer clarity and wisdom from God.

- Proverbs 3:5-6: "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to Him, and He will make your paths straight."
- James 1:5: "If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you."
- Psalm 32:8: "I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my loving eye on you."
- Isaiah 30:21: "Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, 'This is the way; walk in it.'"
- Jeremiah 29:11: "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."



3. Scriptures for Comfort in Grief

In times of loss, these verses offer God's comfort and assurance of His love.

- Matthew 5:4: "Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted."
- Psalm 34:18: "The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit."
- 2 Corinthians 1:3-4: "Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our troubles, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves receive from God."
- John 14:1-3: "Do not let your hearts be troubled. You believe in God; believe also in me. My Father's house has many rooms; if that were not so, would I have told you that I am going there to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am."
- Revelation 21:4: "He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away."

4. Scriptures for Strength and Endurance

When you feel weak and weary, these verses remind you that God's strength is made perfect in your weakness.

- Isaiah 40:31: "But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint."
- 2 Corinthians 12:9-10: "But He said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.' Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me. That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong."
- Psalm 73:26: "My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever."
- Philippians 4:13: "I can do all this through Him who gives me strength."
- Joshua 1:9: "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go."



5. Scriptures for Hope and Encouragement

When you need a reminder of God's promises and the hope we have in Christ, these verses provide encouragement.

- Romans 15:13: "May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in Him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit."
- Jeremiah 29:11: "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."
- Romans 8:28: "And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love Him, who have been called according to His purpose."
- Psalm 33:20-22: "We wait in hope for the Lord; He is our help and our shield. In Him our hearts rejoice, for we trust in His holy name. May Your unfailing love be with us, Lord, even as we put our hope in You."
- Hebrews 10:23: "Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for He who promised is faithful."

6. Scriptures for Healing

When you or someone you love is facing illness or injury, these verses offer God's healing and comfort.

- 3 John 1:2: "Dear friend, I pray that you may enjoy good health and that all may go well with you, even as your soul is getting along well."
- James 5:14-15: "Is anyone among you sick? Let them call the elders of the church to pray over them and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise them up. If they have sinned, they will be forgiven."
- Isaiah 53:5: "But He was pierced for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on Him, and by His wounds we are healed."
- Psalm 103:2-4: "Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not all His benefits—who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion."
- Jeremiah 30:17: "But I will restore you to health and heal your wounds," declares the Lord."



7. Scriptures for Provision and Financial Needs

When you're facing financial struggles, these verses remind you of God's provision and care.

- Philippians 4:19: "And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of His glory in Christ Jesus."
- Matthew 6:31-33: "So do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well."
- Psalm 37:25: "I was young and now I am old, yet I have never seen the righteous forsaken or their children begging bread."
- 2 Corinthians 9:8: "And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work."
- Proverbs 3:9-10: "Honor the Lord with your wealth, with the first fruits of all your crops; then your barns will be filled to overflowing, and your vats will brim over with new wine."

8. Scriptures for Forgiveness and Reconciliation

When you're struggling to forgive or seeking reconciliation, these verses guide you toward peace and healing.

- Ephesians 4:32: "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you."
- Colossians 3:13: "Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you."
- Matthew 6:14-15: "For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive others their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins."
- Romans 12:18: "If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone."
- Luke 6:37: "Do not judge, and you will not be judged. Do not condemn, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven."



9. Scriptures for Faith and Trust

When your faith is wavering or you're struggling to trust God, these verses reinforce your trust in Him.

- Proverbs 3:5: "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding."
- Hebrews 11:1: "Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see."
- Mark 11:24: "Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours."
- Psalm 56:3-4: "When I am afraid, I put my trust in you. In God, whose word I praise—in God I trust and am not afraid. What can mere mortals do to me?"
- Isaiah 26:3: "You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in you."

10. Scriptures for Encouragement in Serving Others

When you're feeling weary in serving others, these verses offer motivation and remind you of the importance of serving with a joyful heart.

- Galatians 6:9: "Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up."
- 1 Peter 4:10: "Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms."
- Matthew 5:16: "In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven."
- Hebrews 13:16: "And do not forget to do good and to share with others, for with such sacrifices God is pleased."
- Mark 10:45: "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many."



11. Scriptures for Patience and Waiting on God

When you're struggling with impatience or waiting for God's timing, these verses remind you of the value of patience and trust.

- Psalm 27:14: "Wait for the Lord; be strong and take heart and wait for the Lord."
- Lamentations 3:25-26: "The Lord is good to those whose hope is in Him, to the one who seeks Him; it is good to wait quietly for the salvation of the Lord."
- Romans 8:25: "But if we hope for what we do not yet have, we wait for it patiently."
- James 5:7-8: "Be patient, then, brothers and sisters, until the Lord's coming. See how the farmer waits for the land to yield its valuable crop, patiently waiting for the autumn and spring rains. You too, be patient and stand firm, because the Lord's coming is near."
- Isaiah 40:31: "But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint."

12. Scriptures for Peace in Troubling Times

When the world feels chaotic and peace is hard to find, these verses help you find solace in God's peace.

- John 16:33: "I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world."
- Philippians 4:7: "And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."
- Isaiah 26:3: "You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in you."
- Psalm 4:8: "In peace I will lie down and sleep, for you alone, Lord, make me dwell in safety."
- Colossians 3:15: "Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful."



13. Scriptures for Joy and Rejoicing

When you need a reminder to rejoice in all circumstances, these verses bring joy and gratitude to the forefront.

- Philippians 4:4: “Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!”
- Nehemiah 8:10: “The joy of the Lord is your strength.”
- Psalm 118:24: “The Lord has done it this very day; let us rejoice today and be glad.”
- Romans 15:13: “May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in Him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.”
- 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18: “Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God’s will for you in Christ Jesus.”
